



Terms and Conditions of the EduNova IB Entrance Scholarship Program (2010)

Please read the terms and conditions carefully before completing the application to ensure that you are eligible for consideration.

Basic eligibility criteria

The EduNova IB Entrance Scholarships are available to:

- international students (non-Canadian citizens).
- current registered students in an International Baccalaureate Diploma program.
- students who are currently attending secondary school full-time.
- students who have never attended post-secondary studies.

Terms and Conditions

1. Scholarships may be redeemed at any of the participating Nova Scotia universities: Dalhousie, Saint Mary's, St. Francis Xavier, Acadia, Nova Scotia Agricultural College, Université Sainte Anne, Mount Saint Vincent, Nova Scotia College of Art and Design University and Cape Breton University.
2. Scholarships valued at CDN \$5,000 per annum are available to students who have been accepted into the first year of full-time university studies at a participating university.
3. IB Entrance Scholarships are tenable only at the beginning of the academic year (September, 2010) immediately following the award.
4. The scholarship winners will be required to submit a confirmation of enrolment from their selected university to EduNova who will then issue the cheque, co-payable to the student and host institution.
5. IB Entrance Scholarships are tenable for one year only. Students must remain registered in a full course load in each of the fall and winter terms as defined by the host institution.
6. Scholarships are only available to international students (non-Canadian citizens) who will graduate with an IB diploma.
7. This scholarship may be used in addition to any other scholarships, bursaries, endowments or prizes that student may receive.

8. All scholarship applications should be received by April 1st, 2010. Applications will be screened and evaluated based upon the following criteria: scholarship eligibility, academic performance, extra-curricular activities, and the school recommendation.
9. An independent committee will review applications and notify accepted students of their status by April 1st, 2010.

Scholarship Checklist

To be eligible for the EduNova International Baccalaureate (IB) Entrance Scholarship, please follow these simple steps:

1. Go online to www.edunova.ca/student and click on the IB Scholarships tab on the right hand column of the page. Complete the registration process and attach or paste your personal letter and a reference letter from your schools IB Coordinator to the application form.
 - a) Interested candidates should write a letter of approximately 500 words addressing at least two of the following topics: their role in global citizenship, their involvement in internationalization and extra-curricular activities, their interest in studying in Nova Scotia, and why they are a deserving candidate for the scholarship.
 - b) Letters from IB coordinators can be standard letters of reference.
2. If you are shortlisted for the scholarship you will be contacted via email and asked to send a sealed, official transcript from your high school and a personal reference.
